

## Preamble

This file demonstrates how `icite` can be used to produce an index of passages cited without using either `BBTEX` or `BibLATEX`.

The relevant part of the preamble which is used here follows:

### Remarks

- (a) `defaultindex=none` disables indexing by default.
- (b) `nobibengine` instructs `icite` to insert the citations in the body text without using either `BBTEX` or `BibLATEX`.
- (c) `\IndexSubtypeAs{ancient}{icite-nobiblatex-primary}` makes an exception for authors whose `entrysubtype` field matches the string `ancient` and instructs `icite` to have them indexed in an index named `icite-nobiblatex-primary`.
- (d) To actually produce the index, `\printindex[icite-nobiblatex-primary]` is needed at the end of the document.
